Robert K. Devies, Ph.D. ('64) is a co-founder of Psychological and Family Consultants, Inc. (PFC) in Canton. He earned a B.A. in psychology and M.A. in rehabilitation counseling from Bowling Green State University. He later earned an M.A. in clinical psychology from Akron

University and Ph.D. from Kent State University. He holds membership in the American Psychological Association (Divisions of Neuropsychology, Health Psychology, Independent Practice of Psychology and Rehabilitation Psychology), Ohio Psychological Association, and National Registry of Health Service Providers in Psychology. Dr. Devies holds privileges at Aultman and Alliance Community Hospitals and Affinity Medical Center. He has also held clinical professorships in psychology at Ohio University School of Osteopathic Medicine and Northeast Ohio Universities College of Medicine.

After working in community corrections and vocational rehabilitation from 1968 through 1975, Dr. Devies established PFC in 1976. From 1973 to 1982 he was Associate Professor and Chairman of the Departments of Psychology and Graduate School of Counseling at Walsh University. From 1983 he has been the consulting psychologist for the Internal Medicine residency program at Aultman Hospital and Assistant Professor in the Department of Internal Medicine at Northeast Ohio Universities College of Medicine. Finally, Dr. Devies has served PFC as president or chief executive officer since 1995.

PFC practice specialty areas include adult forensic psychology, medical inpatient/outpatient consultation, rehabilitation, criminal and civil court consultation, and assessment and treatment of emergency service providers.



Joyeanna (Sheaffer) Jones ('07) is an Intervention Specialist at Stow - Munroe Falls High School, where she has served for the past seven years. Following graduation from Marlington in 2007, Joye followed Lake graduate Dave Jones to Kent State University


26th Annual Golf Outing Raises More Than \$16,000 for Scholarships

The Mike and Linda Pauli and Family Scholarship was established in 2022 to support worthy Marlington seniors pursuing two-year tech or trade programs.

Mike ('68) and Linda (Hoover) Pauli ('68) started dating as sophomores at Marlington and married in 1969. Mike began performing electrical work as an

apprentice in the early 1970's. After serving in the US Army, Mike founded Pauli Electric in 1975 as a one-man shop. Early on, the company performed primarily residential and farm work. In the early years, Linda helped with billing and administrating payroll.

The company's reputation for quality work grew through the years as did its size. Today, Pauli Electric provides residential, farm, industrial and commercial electrical work, and services fire alarm systems and generators. The company has 18 dedicated employees, a number of whom are fellow Marlington graduates.

Mike serves as a Lexington Township trustee. He's active in the Alliance Chamber of Commerce, the Alliance Area Development Foundation, Independent Electrical Contractors Association, Better Business Bureau, and the Eastern Stark County Safety Council. Mike served on the Stark Development Board and was the Alliance Chamber of Commerce president. In 2007 he was the recipient of the Chamber's Spirit of Enterprise award. "The community is good to me, so it's easy to give back," said Mike. "I enjoy working with people and have made a lot of good relationships through service."

Linda earned her Nursing Degree from Walsh University, her bachelor of Arts in Management from Malone University, and has completed post-graduate work at the University of Akron. She has a Licensed Practical Nurse certificate from Timken Mercy Hospital School of Practical Nursing, an Emergency Medical Technician certificate from Alliance Community Hospital, and a Pharmacy Technician Certificate from Stark State College.

With a passion for education and lifelong learning, Linda served 25 years as the Director of the Student Health Center at the University of Mount Union where she established many health-related educational opportunities for students including writing a health newsletter and establishing a health fair for students.

Linda was the first to obtain additional credentialing from the American Nurses Credentialing Center, recognizing the specialty of College Health Nursing and showing expertise in that field of nursing.

She attended book clubs and other events at Rodman Public Library, where she was well-known, and shared her passion for reading with others through the YWCA book community.

In honor of Ede's heart for students and love for her family, this scholarship will be awarded to students who have succeeded despite difficulties or are pursuing a career in helping others.

Your Legacy, Their Future

One of the Marlington Alumni Association's greatest sources of hope for future Dukes are legacy gifts from alumni and friends like you!

Legacy donors, individuals who have included the MAA in their estate plans, come from all walks of life, some from modest means and some from wealth. Their common ground is their passion for future Dukes and a desire to invest in something that will provide a permanent legacy.

Bequest

A will or trust directs how you want your property distributed upon death. You may consider including the Marlington Alumni Association as a beneficiary in your will, designating a percentage or specific amount.

Wills and trusts must meet certain legal requirements. Talk to an attorney about what is best for you and your family, and how you can also accomplish your philanthropic goals.

Beneficiary Designation

In addition to plans defined by your will or trust, there are also ways you can express your intentions that do not require the assistance of an attorney:

Retirement Plan, IRA, 401(k), 403(b) Beneficiaries

Most retirement assets are subject to both income tax and estate taxes. You may choose to name one or more charities as beneficiary of all or a portion of your retirement account. Upon your death, funds would transfer, free of income or estate tax. Consult your financial institution or investment advisor to update your designations.

Payable on Death (POD) or Transfer on Death (TOD)

You can easily include one or more beneficiaries on your bank account, certificate of deposit, or brokerage account. Simply speak with your financial institution to have a Payable on Death (POD) or Transfer on Death (TOD) designation added to your account. While the notation does not change your ownership, it causes the funds in your account to pass directly to your named beneficiaries upon your death.

Insurance Beneficiary Designation

You may name one or more charities as the beneficiaries of part/all of the death benefit from an insurance policy. As with POD/TOD options, your beneficiary designation might give a portion to charity and provide for the balance to be divided as you designate. You can make a beneficiary change on your own or with the assistance of your insurance agent.

Donation of Appreciated Securities

To avoid paying capital gains tax, consider a gift of your appreciated stocks, now or in the future. You can support the program of your choice and deduct the full value of the security. Your bank or investment advisor can conveniently administer the transaction.

Suggested Gift Designation Language

A charitable bequest to the Marlington Alumni Association can easily be written into your will using language such as this: "I give and bequeath to the Marlington Alumni Association (MAA), tax Identification Number 34-1670638, PO Box 6001, Alliance, OH 44601 (Insert specific amount, asset, or percentage of your estate)."
