
fire alarm systems and generators. The company now has 18 dedicated employees, many of whom are fellow Marlington graduates.

Liber Service Award Permanently Endowed

Since 1968, the John Liber Service Award has been annually awarded to a Marlington student who has demonstrated genuine concern for others, a concern which reflects itself in the form of active and unselfish service within the school and community.

This longstanding Marlington recognition was recently endowed by William Liber ('65), and Nancy Liber, wife of the late John. D. Liber, ensuring the permanent legacy of this award.

John Liber served on the Marlington School Board for 17 years and spearheaded the drive to build Washington School, Lexington School, and the Marlington High School (MHS). Mr. Liber unselfishly devoted most of his adult working life to improving the education opportunities for the children of the Marlington Local School District.

This award is not based on grade point average, but more on character, service to school and community, and concern for the welfare of others.

The recipient receives an award of \$1,000, and their name is added to a plaque hanging at the entrance to Marlington High School. Annual selection of the recipient(s) will be made by a combination of the Marlington High School guidance department, teachers, and administrators of Marlington High School.

Your Legacy, Their Future

One of the Marlington Alumni Association's greatest sources of hope for future Dukes are legacy gifts from alumni and friends like you!

Legacy donors, individuals who have included the MAA in their estate plans, come from all walks of life, some from modest means and some from wealth. Their common ground is their passion for future Dukes and a desire to invest in something that will provide a permanent legacy.

Bequest

A will or trust directs how you want your property distributed upon death. You may consider including the Marlington Alumni Association as a beneficiary in your will, designating a percentage or specific amount.

Wills and trusts meet certain legal requirements. Talk to an attorney about what is best for you and your family, and how you can also accomplish your philanthropic goals.

Beneficiary Designation

In addition to plans defined by your will or trust, there are also ways you can express your intentions that do not require the assistance of an attorney:

Retirement Plan, IRA, 401(k), 403(b) Beneficiaries

Most retirement assets are subject to both income tax and estate taxes. You may choose to name one or more charities as beneficiary of all or a portion of your retirement account. Upon your death, funds would transfer, free of income or estate tax. Consult your financial institution or investment advisor to update your designations.

Payable on Death (POD) or Transfer on Death (TOD)

You can easily include one or more beneficiaries on your bank account, certificate of deposit or brokerage account. Simply speak with your financial institution to have a Payable on Death (POD) or Transfer on Death (TOD) designation added to your account. While the notation does not change your ownership, it causes the funds in your account to pass directly to your named beneficiaries upon your death.

Insurance Beneficiary Designation

You may name one or more charities as the beneficiaries of part/all of the death benefit from an insurance policy. As with POD/TOD options, your beneficiary designation might give a portion to charity and provide for the balance to be divided as you designate. You can make a beneficiary

change on your own or with the assistance of your insurance agent.

Donation of Appreciated Securities

To avoid paying capital gains tax, consider a gift of your appreciated stocks, now or in the future. You can support the program of your choice and deduct the full value of the security. Your bank or investment advisor can conveniently administer the transaction.

Suggested Gift Designation Language

A charitable bequest to the Marlington Alumni Association can easily be written into your will using language such as this: "I give and bequeath to the Marlington Alumni Association (MAA), tax Identification Number 34-1670638, PO Box 6001, Alliance, OH 44601 (Insert specific amount, asset, or percentage of your estate)."

Reduce Your Taxes and Support the MAA

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act charitable deduction has been extended to 2021 and expanded for married couples. If you don't itemize your deductions, you may receive a \$300 deduction as a single filer. Married couples may qualify for a \$600 deduction. Charitable contributions must be made on or before December 31, 2021. Consult your tax advisor for complete details.
