For nearly 35 years the Marlinton Alumni Association (MAA) has been an important part of the Duke Community. From the first five students who graduated from Marlboro High School in 1927, to the 135 students who graduated from Marlinton High School in 2023, the MAA has been the repository of information for almost 15,000 alumni, faculty, and friends of Marlinton.

In Memoriam



Shauna Zurbrugg ('69) died in 2023. She was born in 1951 in Alliance, Ohio to Erskine Lewis Zurbrugg and Geraldine Zurbrugg, who owned and ran the Zurbrugg Cider Mill. Shauna's early days were filled with playing at and then working at her father's store.

Shauna's first love was being dramatic, so she acted throughout her years at Marlinton High School, her favorite role being that of Bett in Oliver. After attending Penn Hall in Pennsylvania, Shauna made her way to Cleveland to become the first woman on Cleveland radio as a morning, drive-time DJ for WMMS-FM/100.7 and WNCN-FM/99.5. Her unmistakable voice mesmerized listeners and propelled her to Los Angeles, where she later debuted at legendary rock station, KLOS.

After radio, Shauna moved to television's Entertainment Tonight, producing segments with Stevie Wonder, Grace Jones, Chrissie Hynde, and Lou Reed. For more than ten years she worked at the first audiobook company, Dove Audio, as an audiobook producer, abridger, and narrator. During her time there she abridged over two hundred books and worked with best-selling authors, Amy Tan, Erica Jong, Paul Theroux, and voice artists, Sharon Stone and Melissa Manchester, among others. Two of her produced audiobooks were nominated for Grammy awards in the Best-Spoken Word category. Most recently, she was developing several short stories she had written into film and television projects.

Following her death, the MAA was able to help the executor of her estate donate more the 100 audio books, produced by Shauna, to Rodman Public Library.

The MAA Congratulates 2023 MAA Outstanding Alumni, Clyde Lepley

Clyde Lepley was born and raised on a vegetable farm in Marlboro Township. He attended Marlboro Elementary and graduated from Marlinton High School in 1968. A leader at a young age, Lepley was a basketball letterman, co-captain of his Federal League Championship team, and President of his senior class.

With a goal of education in mind, he attended the University of Mount Union, graduating in 1972 with a major in Biology and Education.

He attended Youngstown State University where he earned a Master's in Secondary Administration and attended The Ohio State University, Ashland University, Franciscan University of Steubenville, and Walsh University for post-master's studies in Education and Administration with a City Superintendent Certificate.

He taught Biology and Physiology at Marlinton High School from 1972-1981. He was JV and Varsity Assistant Basketball Coach under four head coaches during those ten years, class advisor, and 1979 Marlinton High School Teacher of the Year. He was named to the Greater Stark County Amateur Basketball Association Hall of Fame in 2016.

Clyde was a Science Consultant for the Stark County Department of Education from 1981-1984, MHS Assistant Principal from 1984-1986, and Principal from 1986-1988. He was Curriculum Director for Louisville City Schools from 1988-1993, responsible for K-12 curricula for the district's 3,400 students until becoming Superintendent from 1993-2008.

Lepley served from 1972-1993 in the United States Army Reserve, enlisting with the 350th Evacuation Hospital.

Clyde has been a member of the Union Avenue United Methodist Church since 1973, serving in various roles including Lead Usher, Men's Club, finance committee, endowment committee, spaghetti dinners team captain, Apple Dumpling Gang, and Sunday school teacher. He has been Chairman of the Administrative Council since 2005 and co-chair of the Building Ministries Team since 2012.

Also, an active community member, Clyde has been a member of the Louisville Kiwanis Club for 23 years, serving as secretary for seven years and President for two years. It is the privilege of the Marlinton Alumni Association to recognize Clyde Lepley as the recipient of the Outstanding Alumni Award for 2023. Congratulations Clyde!

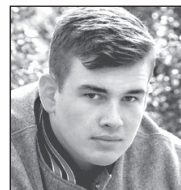
