
needed to create an MAA YouTube channel. If you were unable to attend the event, and would like to



New Strouble Family Scholarship Supports Horticulture, Agriculture

The Marlington Alumni Association is pleased to partner with the Strouble Family to establish the Howard and Berdine Strouble Scholarship. Loyal Dukes and active members of the district's farming and 4-H community, this scholarship will support students pursuing two or four-year post-secondary programs in horticulture, agriculture or any related field including veterinary medicine, agri-business, farming, etc.

Howard and Berdine married in 1955, moving into the 124 year old family farmhouse. Howard ran the grain and dairy farm, milking until he was 76 years old. Berdine managed more than 300 chickens, and for years delivered 40 dozen eggs a week, selling them to local businesses and families for fifty cents a dozen. To supplement their income, Berdine was a school bus driver, first for Lake Local Schools, then for Marlington, retiring at age 70. Her fun-loving but no-nonsense personality

made her one of Marlington's favorite drivers.

Each of the five Strouble children and many of their 14 grandchildren and 16 great grandchildren are Marlington graduates. Loyal followers of Duke football, they can boast that for more than ten years there was a Strouble playing varsity football.

Ron Davis graduated from Marlboro High School in 1951. After high school he obtained a business degree from Ohio University, then joined the US Air

Force where he trained as a fighter pilot. In 1958, he and his wife Mary moved to Hartville to lead the Buckeye Packaging Company, a company begun by his father in 1948.

The Marlboro Twp. based manufactures company rolls of plastic, which can be printed and made into plastic bags. During his nearly 35 President, years as Ron grew the company from three employees to 75 and served customers throughout Midwest. Twenty-five years retirement, after his company continues to thrive and is a significant employer in the area and supporter of local teams and other nonprofits.

Over the decades, Ron has continued to play a role in the

Marlington Local School district. He has consistently organized his high school class reunion which still meets after more than 65 years. Ron also endowed one of the Marlington Alumni Association's first scholarships, in the name of his father, Ford C. Davis. Including the 2020 award, this scholarship has provided nearly \$50,000 in support of students

entering Engineering or related fields.

Ron has been a lifelong resident of the area and supported many important organizations. He has


been active in Lake Local Schools, where all three of his children graduated. He has also supported the Stark Community Foundation, North Canton YMCA, and Faith United Methodist Church. He was a member of Hartville City Council and is a past President of the Hartville Lions Club.





Your Legacy, Their Future

One of the Marlington Alumni Association's greatest sources of hope for future Dukes are legacy gifts from alumni and friends like you!

Legacy donors, individuals who have included the MAA in their estate plans, come from all walks of life, some from modest means and some from wealth. Their common ground is their passion for future Dukes and a desire to invest in something that will provide a permanent legacy.

Bequest

A will or trust directs how you want your property distributed upon death. You may consider including the Marlington Alumni Association as a beneficiary in your will, designating a percentage or specific amount.

Wills and trusts meet certain legal requirements. Talk to an attorney about what is best for you and your family, and how you can also accomplish your philanthropic goals.

Beneficiary Designation

In addition to plans defined by your will or trust, there are also ways you can express your intentions that do not require the assistance of an attorney:

Retirement Plan, IRA, 401(k), 403(b) Beneficiaries

Most retirement assets are subject to both income tax and estate taxes. You may choose to name one or more charities as beneficiary of all or a portion of your retirement account. Upon your death, funds would transfer, free of income or estate tax. Consult your financial institution or investment advisor to update your designations.

Payable on Death (POD) or Transfer on Death (TOD)

You can easily include one or more beneficiaries on your bank account, certificate of deposit or brokerage account. Simply speak with your financial institution to have a Payable on Death (POD) or Transfer on Death (TOD) designation added to your account. While the notation does not change your ownership, it causes the funds in your account to

pass directly to your named beneficiaries upon your death.

Insurance Beneficiary Designation

You may name one or more charities as the beneficiaries of part/all of the death benefit from an insurance policy. As with POD/TOD options, your beneficiary designation might give a portion to charity and provide for the balance to be divided as you designate. You can make a beneficiary change on your own or with the assistance of your insurance agent.

Donation of Appreciated Securities

To avoid paying capital gains tax, consider a gift of your appreciated stocks, now or in the future. You can support the program of your choice and deduct the full value of the security. Your bank or investment advisor can conveniently administer the transaction.

Suggested Gift Designation Language

A charitable bequest to the Marlington Alumni Association can easily be written into your will using language such as this: "I give and bequeath to the Marlington Alumni Association (MAA), tax Identification Number 34-1670638, PO Box 6001, Alliance, OH 44601 (Insert specific amount, asset, or percentage of your estate)."
