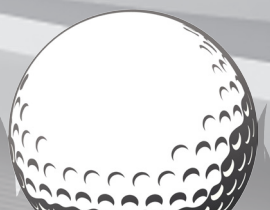

When football coach Dale Herbert asked Lair and a few teammates if they were going to attend college, the young men were uncertain. Coach Herbert saw potential and personally arranged for the boys to visit Baldwin Wallace College. With that encouragement, and a strong desire to play football, Lair attended college.

Lair encouraged teachers not to underestimate the power they hold, saying that a simple kindness can change the trajectory of a child's life." He encouraged students to follow their passion, the things in their heart. "Then do what you're good at, he said, People will notice. You will succeed."
